



Bill Meyer - 1994

Bill Meyer, Jr. became a PGA Member in 1950, and held that distinction until his death in 1994. He began his career as an assistant professional at Big Spring Country Club for three years, as the head golf professional at Owl Creek Country Club for ten years and as the head professional at Midland Trail Golf Club from 1965-1990. He was President of the Kentucky Section PGA from 1968-1969, and from 1970-71. He was selected as the KPGA Golf Professional of the Year in 1968 and 1981, and was the recipient of the Bill Strausbaugh Award in 1985. He served as PGA of America Vice President in 1972, representing the Carolinas, Middle Atlantic and Kentucky Sections.
