Colonel Lee S. Read, a Louisville native, is considered the “Father of Junior Golf” in Kentucky. He was a long-time member of the first USGA Junior Golf Committee and served as starter at the USGA Junior Amateur Championship and the U.S. Open Championship for a number of years. He was the founder of the Tri-State Junior Championship, and was very active in the Southern Golf Association, where he served as a member of the Board of Directors from 1938-53, and as President from 1952-1953.
