ENTRY FEE

*All successful qualifiers and exempt contestants will be charged an additional \$100.00 prior to the championship. This fee shall be paid at time of registration at the championship venue.

*Professionals with no Kentucky Section PGA affiliation will be charged an additional \$500.00 if successful in qualifying.

WITHDRAWAL/REFUND POLICY

Requests for refunds must be submitted in writing and will be subject to the following:

1. Prior to deadline > Entry fee refund minus \$5 service fee
2. Prior to the first date of competition > Fee minus \$15 service fee
3. After competition begins > \$0 refund*

*Exception - medical emergency; fee minus \$15 service fee

ELIGIBILITY

Kentucky Section PGA Golf Professionals and Apprentices eligible to compete in Kentucky Section PGA tournament events and Non-Member Kentucky Resident Professionals. An amateur competing in the Kentucky Open shall be required to have an active Handicap Index at a Kentucky Golf Association Member Club at the time of entry. The current USGA Handicap Index shall be based on records effective on the posted revision date.

Entries are subject to approval or rejection, with or without reason, at any time at the discretion of the Kentucky Section PGA.

2015 Kentucky Open Championship

Mother Nature saved the best for last in the 96th Kentucky Open at Keene Trace Golf Club (Champions Course) on Thursday, July 30. It was a breezy, comfortable day that allowed the golf course to firm up and make scoring conditions difficult for the 75 players who teed it up in the final round.

Some of those players, like Kent Bulle of Glasgow, had to finish their second round at 7:30 a.m. on Thursday, after an afternoon of shaky weather on Wednesday. That seemed to be no problem for the Latin America PGA Tour player, who managed a second round 66 to take the clubhouse lead by one shot over Salt Lick's Logan Hogge at 137. The two were in the final pairing together with Pikeville's Robert Damron at 2:00 p.m.

Scores proved to be a bit higher with dryer conditions – but no one seemed to tell the final two groups that. Some great golf and a tight race went on between Bulle, Hogge, Shelbyville's Brandon Brown and Lexington's Joseph Deraney. With about three holes left to play, Brown and Hogge were knotted at ten-under-par and Bulle and Deraney at nine-under-par for the Championship. Hogge made a costly three putt bogey on 17 and Brown found the water hazard off of the 18th tee box to both fall off the lead. It was then that Bulle, who played steadily all day long, emerged as the winner with a solid round of one-under-par 71 and a nine-under-par total. Hogge, the 2015 Amateur Champion, finished Runner-Up one shot behind Bulle and was the Low Amateur in the field. That certainly solidifies him as the best amateur in the State!

The day belonged to Bulle, who like 2013 & 2014 Champ, Rick Cochran, III is having a great season on the Latin American PGA Tour. In fact, Cochran and Bulle were college teammates at Middle Tennessee State University! Congratulations to Kent on three terrific days of golf that were fun to watch!
