-  Nominee must have been a Kentucky resident for a minimum of five years.
-  Nominee should have contributed to the golf industry in one or more of the following areas: Playing achievements, Contributions/Promotion of the Game, Contribution to Junior Golf, Teaching of the game, Golf Course Architecture, Turf Grass Research, Golf Course Management/Maintenance, and National recognition
-  Nominees remain active for three years. Nominations with no activity for three years are removed from consideration by the committee.
-  Currently Active Nominees (nomination form not required, but supporting materials are encouraged to keep nomination active): Robert “Bobby” Baldwin, Marsha Bordas, Betty Baird Kregor, Jim Brown, Rick Cain, Dianne Dailey, Jerry Edwards, Bill Sergent, Don Smith, and George “Skip” Stigger.
