Conditions of Play

Entries

The Clark's Pump-N-Shop Marathon Kentucky Amateur Championship has been conducted annually since 1911 and has crowned many of the Commonwealth's legendary golfers. Names such as Gay Brewer, Jr., Bobby Nicholas, Frank Beard, John Owens, Bill Musselman, Jodie Mudd and J.B. Holmes are now engraved on the championship trophy.

Field

The 156 player field is cut to the top 70 and ties after 36-holes of competition.

Format

This championship is the flagship tournament for the KGA and is contested over 54 holes of stroke play competition. Players reach the championship by either qualifying at a section site or earning an exemption into the championship field.

Practice Rounds

The official date of the practice round is June 11. Competitors will contact the Bellefonte Golf Shop to make arrangements for that date at (606) 324.2107.

Rules of Play

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf and the Decisions based upon them published by the United States Golf Association and, where applicable, by the following Local Rules and Definitions. Appendix I refers to Appendix of Local Rules in the USGA Rules of Golf booklet. Pace of Play is strictly enforced.

All contestants reaching the final round and posting a 54 hole score will receive a gift certificate redeemable through the Bellefonte Golf

The final round of the Clark's Pump-N-Shop | Marathon Kentucky Amateur on June 18 was a hot and humid one at Big Spring Country Club Inc.'s Big Spring Campus. It was a white hot fight to finish as well! Logan Hogge of Salt Lick seemed to be in full control after shooting two-under-par on the first nine holes. 2013 Amateur Champion, Tyler McDaniel of Manchester made a late charge to cut the lead to one shot through 15 holes. The Morehead State golfer (Hogge) and the University of Kentucky golfer (McDaniel) both stumbled with double bogeys late in their round but Hogge was able to comfortably two putt on the 18th hole for par and the victory. Little did he know 2014 Kentucky Golf Association John Owens Player of the Year, Denver Haddix, Jr. of Lexington and Drew Allenspach of Louisville were only a shot shy of him, after both players shot the round of the tournament, five-under-par 67 on Thursday afternoon. Haddix and Allenspach share the Runner-Up title and trophy in 2015. This is Haddix's second Runner-Up Amateur and Allenspach celebrated his birthday during the final round.



Congratulations to Logan Hogge on a fantastic wire-to-wire victory with a four-underpar 212. Hogge seemed in awe of having his named among some of the best in Kentucky on the Amateur trophy. His story is pretty incredible, growing up being hooked on golf as a middle schooler and playing with his family. There is not a golf course in Salt Lick, so Hogge played around many municipal courses. He not only claimed the Overall Championship, he won awards for the Low First Round (68) and the Uncle Joe Dickson Award for Low Public Links player.

Other Award Winners included: David Jasper of Prospect for the Low Second Round (68), Allenspach and Haddix for the Low Third Round (67), the Colonel Lee Reed Award (for Low Junior golfer) to Allen Hamilton of Louisville and John Gagai of Ironton took home the Harreld Kirkpatrick Award for Low Senior Golfer.
